## Holy Saturday Pre55 vs 1955 From restorethe54.com

The most obvious change will be the time. Since 1566 (and in most places, long before 1566), the Holy Saturday liturgy (Easter Vigil) was celebrated in the morning. The common practice in the United States in the 1940s was 8am.
